  - \_\_\_\_\_ NICS-FS
  - \_\_\_\_\_ ICS-100
  - \_\_\_\_\_ IS-700.A
  - OR –
- \_\_\_\_\_ *Show documentation of PSFA approval to instruct ICS-300 as a Lead Instructor*

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### NIMS Integration Center Requirements: (Submit supporting documentation)

#### Lead instructor shall have:

- \_\_\_\_\_ training and experience in Adult Education;
- \_\_\_\_\_ experience as an Incident Commander or have served in a command staff or general staff position.

#### Unit instructors shall have:
