

## NOTICE OF FUNDING OPPORTUNITY, ACT 104 OF 2022; EMERGENCY SERVICE TRAINING CENTER CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAM

On Thursday, November 3, 2022, Act 104 of 2022 was signed into law establishing the Emergency Service Training Center Capital Grant Program (ESTCCGP). The ESTCCGP was created with the intent to provide a source of capital funding for Emergency Service Training providers.

Eligible recipients of program funds include emergency services training centers, community colleges, county-owned facilities, municipal or fire department-owned facilities or nonprofit countywide associations. Privately owned facilities are not eligible for program funds.

Eligible categories of expenses are:

- 1. Establish or modernize facilities that house firefighting equipment, ambulances, or rescue vehicles.
- 2. Acquire or renovate existing structures to house firefighting equipment, ambulances, or rescue vehicles or for the construction or modernization of facilities.
- 3. Repair or purchase firefighting, ambulance, or rescue equipment as necessary to provide proper and adequate training.

To begin the application process there are several important pieces of information that need to be completed prior to applying. Please note the turnaround time for the below items as some may take up to three weeks for processing.

## 1. Keystone ID

The agency seeking to certify for the grant will need both signatories to have a username and password registered within the Keystone Login Portal. You may register here: <u>Keystone ID</u>.

## 2. An active Commonwealth Vendor Number

Your organization must have an active Commonwealth Vendor Number for us to process your future grant contract and payments. You will need your organization's Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) to complete this registration. To check if you have an active vendor number, search for your municipality on our list of Verified Active Vendor Records. If your municipality is not listed, you can complete your vendor registration online

## 3. Sign-up for Direct Deposit (ACH payments)

All your future grant payments will be made through the Automated Clearing House (ACH). You will want to check that your vendor record has your bank account information. You can add/change bank account information in your vendor record at the PA Supplier Portal. (See the step-by-step guide for making changes to your vendor record.)

NOTE: The 2024 application window will open April 1 and end on May 15; Requests for extensions will not be granted.
